Principal Terms and Conditions of Employment - Co-ordinator, Children and Young People's Research Network for Wales

Contract:	Until <u>31</u> March 2010 (Secondment cover)
Hours of Work:	This is a full-time post of 35 hours per week. Staff can take time off in lieu if they occasionally work additional hours during the week or at weekends.
Holidays:	25 days per year, plus bank holidays, plus three extra statutory days. The leave year runs from 1st April to 31st March. Up to five days can be carried forward into the first month of the new leave year.
Salary Scale:	£28,595 per annum
Method of pay:	Salaries are paid directly into staff member's nominated bank account on the 15th of each month.
Pension:	Children in Wales' employees may choose to contribute to the Cardiff County Council Local Government Superannuation scheme or alternatively may choose to have a 7.5% employer contribution paid into a scheme of their choice.
Place of work:	25 Windsor Place, Cardiff.
