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## Where are we heading?

All children and young people in Wales ...

- have a flying start in life
- have a comprehensive range of education and learning opportunities
- enjoy the best possible health and are free from abuse, victimisation and exploitation
- have access to play, leisure sporting and cultural activities
- are listened to, treated with respect and have their race and cultural identity recognised
- have a safe home and a community which supports physical and emotional wellbeing, and
- are not disadvantaged by poverty

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## How will we know when we get there?

- Need to measure what is different, not just what we are doing
- In particular - those outcomes from a Partnership approach to planning
- Different to showing outcomes related to services (i.e. performance outcomes)
- Use of same measure if showing the same outcome



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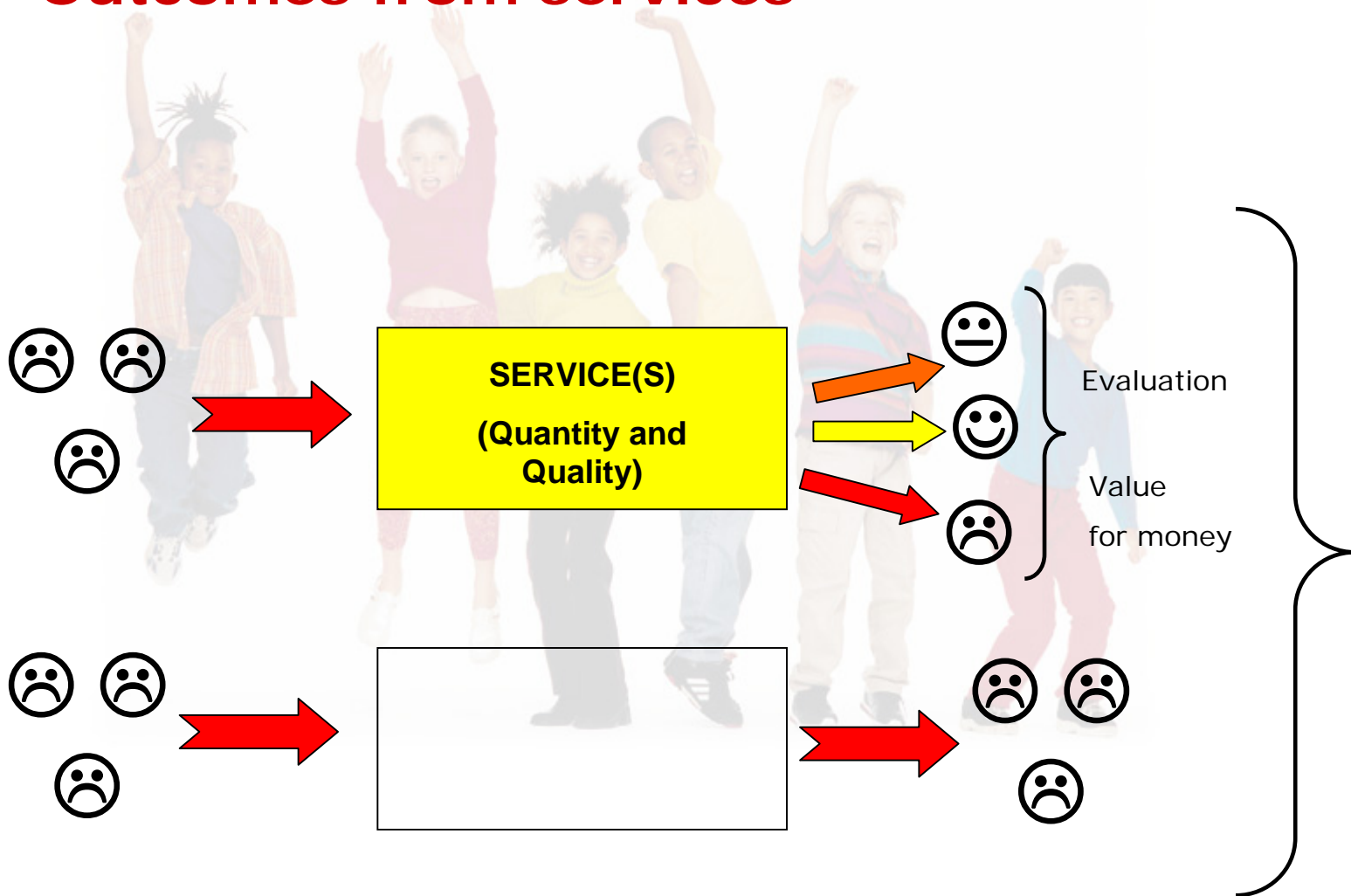
## Rationale for the OMF

- Shift emphasis to *outcomes* ('the ends') rather than *process* ('the means')
- Strengthen partnership approaches to achieving results
- Facilitate comparability between Partnership areas, and with all-Wales measures
- Make links with the UNCRC explicit

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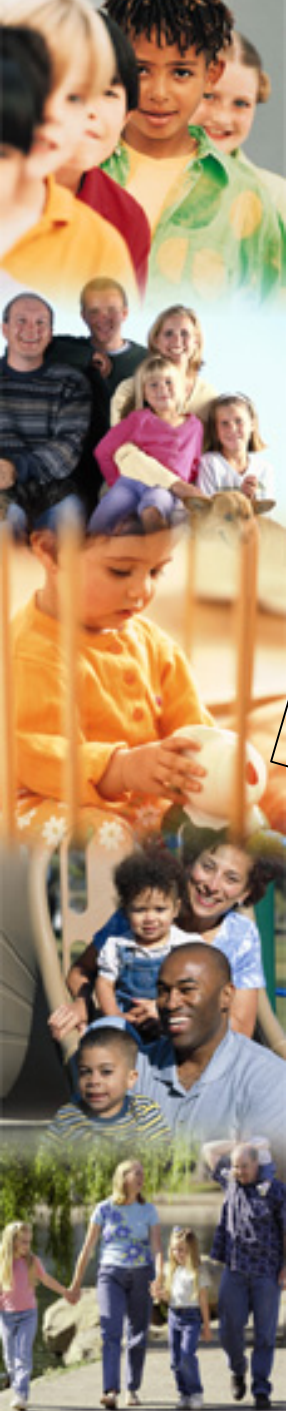
