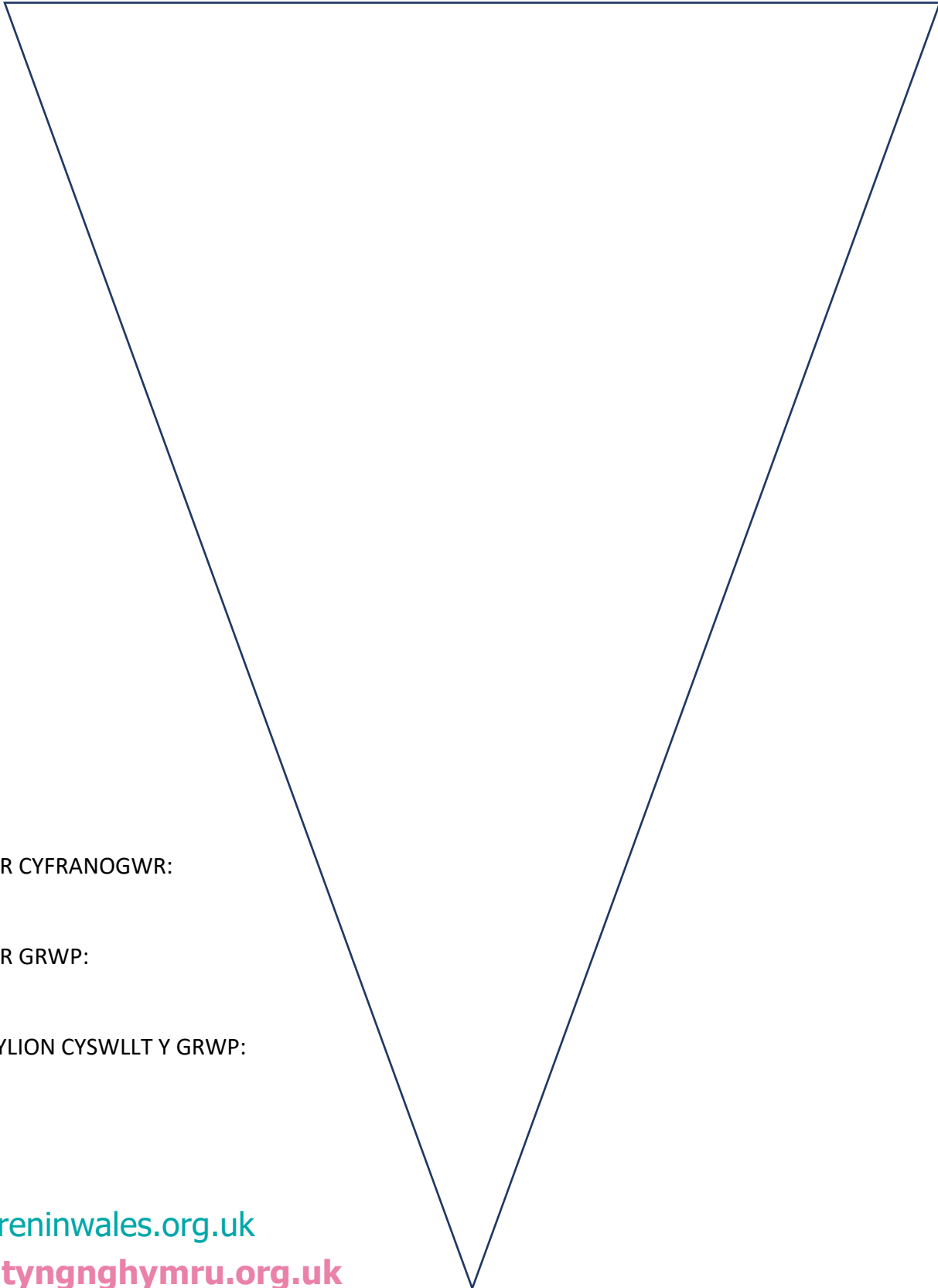
Sut mae gwneud hyn:

BUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

You will need:

- White card or suitable fabric (or paper if scanning)
- Bunting template (included below or create your own)
- Art and craft materials such as paint, colouring pens, pencils, glitter.
- A [list of Children's Rights](#) so that participants can pick which one they want to draw.

How to do it:

- Create / print the bunting template (you can use the template below or create your own), the classic bunting size 16cm for the top edge and 22cm for the sides.
- Leave to dry / set depending on materials
- Once artwork is dry, please ensure that the participant's full name is included on the sheet of paper / bunting so that we can easily select the winner.

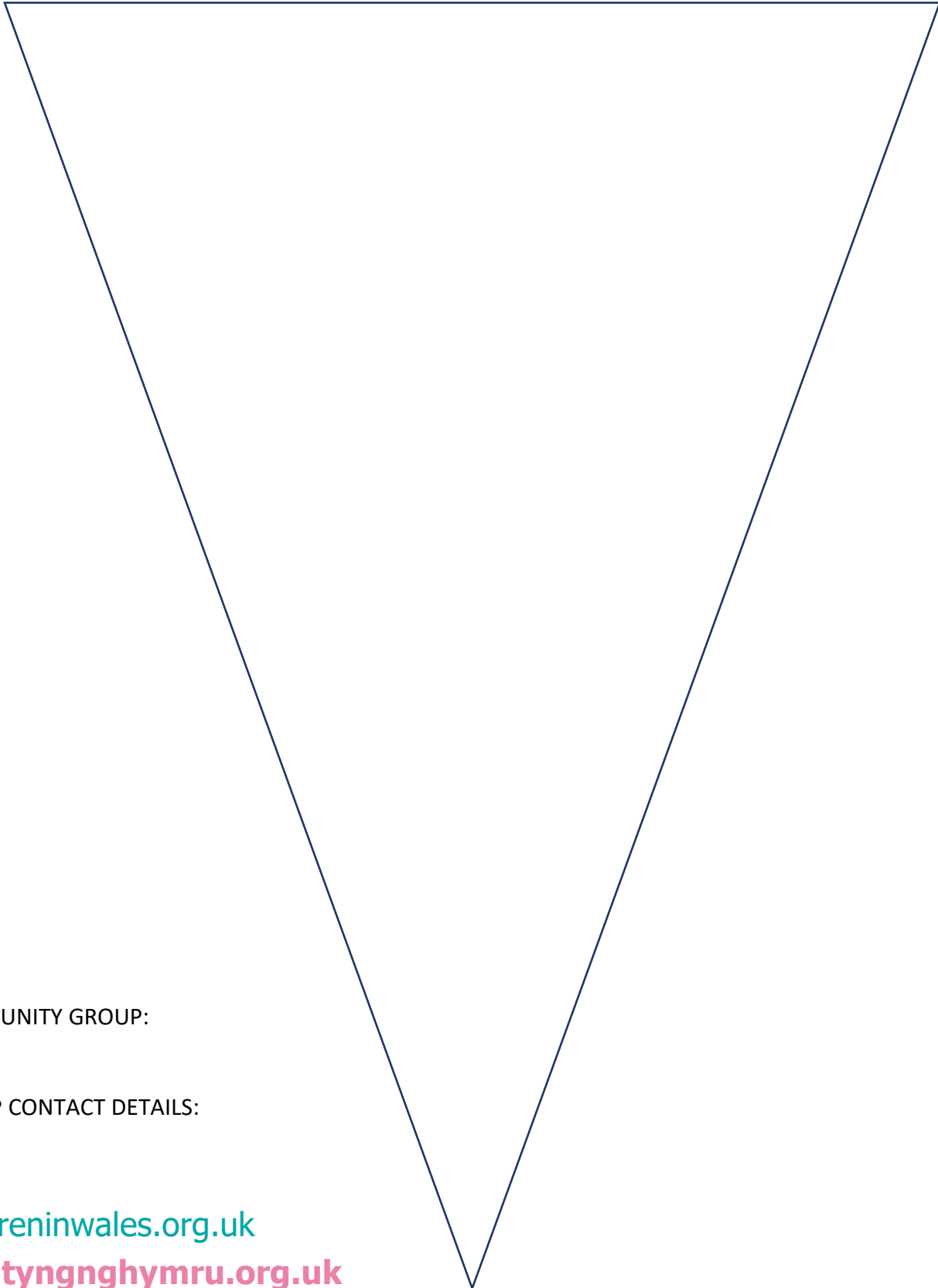
