- Fyddi di'n gallu cyrraedd y gwaith mewn pryd?

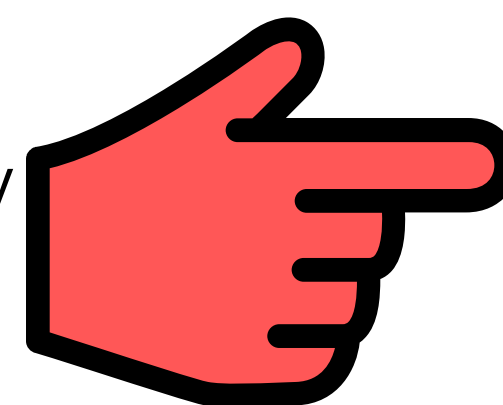


Enghreifftiau o amserau teithio:

### Planning journeys

Use the Traveline site below to plan journeys:

- <https://www.traveline.cymru/>
- See if there are buses or trains between the areas you need to get to/from
- Look at how long it takes
- Look at when the first/last bus of the day is. It is no good if you need to be in work at 9am and the first bus won't get you there until 10am.
- Look at how frequent the service is. If there is a train only every 2 hours does that help you get to where you need to go?

## Travel to College

The College you attend is likely to have options for travel that may include:

- Buses put on by the College just to pick up and drop off students. You will get a bus pass to use these buses
- Bus passes for local buses- you may have to pay towards the cost of these, however ask Student Support in the College you attend
- Local train services- you may have to pay towards the cost of these, however ask Student Support in the College you attend
- If you live less than 2 or 3 miles from the campus they might expect you to make your own way to the College.

## Travel to work

- If you are in work or looking for work you need to think about how you can get to work
- It is not up to the employer to put transport on for staff, it is up to **you** to find your own way!
- You need to think about how much this will cost and include it in your weekly/monthly budget
- **Will it get you to work on time?**



Example journey times:

- Llangefni to Bangor (bus)- 30 minutes
- Valley to Holyhead- 15 minutes
- Amlwch to Holyhead- 1 hour

## Where I live

- Although you are excited about living independently you need to think carefully about where you live
- Is there regular public transport to the nearest town/College? Can you walk/cycle?
- Is there regular public transport to see friends? Can you walk/cycle?
- How long does it take to get to the nearest town? This could be your commute every day if you work



Possible difficulties:

- Limited buses between Amlwch and Holyhead
- Limited buses in villages across Anglesey

## Support from your employer

- Your place of work may be part of the Cycle to Work scheme where you loan a bike from your employer with a small amount taken from your pay each month
- They may be able to offer you a loan to cover the cost of an annual train pass with an amount taken from your pay each month
