Cymru Ifanc - Young Wales is a new project funded by the Welsh Government to help young people get their voices heard

Project launch

Young Wales will be launched next 27 March.

Young people have already shared their local issues, and the day will bring together young people from all over Wales to discuss these, and to finalise their national priorities. They will then meet with people from the Welsh Government to reveal their choices.

Our new website will launch on the same day. We will be on Twitter so there will be lots of ways to keep in touch with what Young Wales is doing. Look out as well for a short film of the day which will be released soon after the launch.

Caught in Traffick film and resources

In the lead up to the launch we are highlighting work that will be on the new site.

Merthyr Tydfil Borough Wide Youth Forum have produced a film and resources on the subject of internal human trafficking and child sexual exploitation. The issue is of growing concern to young people in the county and they decided to develop a film to highlight the risk and how people are targeted.

The work has already been adopted by the Crown Prosecution Service for training their staff, and is also being used by the police, Barnardo's and Llamau.
